This policy has been adopted to address the safety and well-being both of our seminary community and of the churches, agencies, and other institutions that our students and alumni/ae serve. These checks include verification of residency history, searches of county criminal databases for criminal histories and sexual offender lists, and searches of county or other local jurisdictional criminal records of places of residence.

When reviewing admissions applications, the Admissions Committee considers carefully and thoughtfully what applicants say about themselves. In the admissions process, applicants provide information about their personal and academic backgrounds. Failure to make written disclosure of information which the application form requires or misrepresentation in the information supplied constitutes grounds for denial of admission. Where such omissions or misrepresentations become known after matriculation at the seminary, the student is subject to dismissal, by vote of the faculty meeting in executive session.
